John Cameron Mitchell was incredibly successful at preserving the charm and energy of the original Off-Broadway rock opera Hedwig and the Angry Inch from which this film was adapted. Hedwig (John Cameron Mitchell) narrates her story of love and loss, as she recalls the botched sex change and failed marriage to a U.S. serviceman that brought her from communist East Germany to form a band of rock n' roll misfits. Along the way Hedwig has an affair with a shy young man named Tommy (Michael Pitt), who goes on to achieve superstardom with songs written by Hedwig both with and without him. Now as Tommy tours the country playing sold out auditoriums and concert halls, Hedwig follows closely behind appearing at strip malls and coffee shops with her band of eccentrics backing her. All the while the music pauses only for the dry wit of Hedwig's storytelling and clever antidotes. This film and soundtrack are not to be forgotten.
